Greater Bay Airlines' second B737-800 aircraft has arrived in Hong Kong

Greater Bay Airlines (GBA) is pleased to have received its second aircraft in Hong Kong and have completed the necessary requirements on 15 March 2022, and the aircraft is now on the Hong Kong register with registration B-KJB.

GBA plans its fleet expansion according to market demand in the next 5 years.
